P.O. Discussion

Aedan's Analog:

Aedan: "Last week was a great week. I'm really happy with our big events. I got a lot of feedback from a bunch of different students about how they appreciate how they felt included. With that, I'll leave you guys with thinking about ideas of more things we can do."

Mesa's Message:

Mesa: "Great job everyone on Clash. It was brought to my attention that we have a couple of our own students who are planning a prom on a yacht the Friday before prom. Val: "I don't know if it's even happening because it's so soon."

Hailey: "Yeah when I saw that I thought that there was no way it's going to happen."

Pierce: "You guys have to realize that this is real money that we might have to throw away. This could potentially be a really expensive mistake."

Hailey: "I think it's hard to say right now because we all want to go. For another student to decide to do this, I just don't know how we should ask people if they're going to the Dana Prom. I don't know if we can have a chance to see who started it."

Jacqueline: "What if we put dates saying that prices are going up?"

Mesa: "Yeah we can do that, but I just wanted to keep it as cheap as possible. How do you guys feel about opening this up to Juniors because if I don't have the sales up by May 1st I will." Val: "I think it'd be weird to open it up to the juniors because it's a senior catered event."

Mesa: "Yes definitely. I have also been talking to Chris P about other activities we can do. We have line dancing, food, dessert, the hypnotist, and the photo booth. I can't have you guys have a normal dance because the CDC says no. Kate and Kate Hayes have been working on graphics to improve our advertising on what we're offering."

James: "One of the biggest problems I have been hearing is people not knowing what the other activities are."

Mesa: "Yes definitely. From what it sounds like you guys want this to go on, and if this changes I need to know by Wednesday."

Hailey: "Ok I think Helena is talking to her as well. I will get back to you hopefully by today. I definitely think this is something that we want."

Senior Director of Recognition:

Jack: "So for Fine Arts they're going to be doing more posts about choir singers, and they're going to be working on doing more of the SOSCA student of the week. For teacher they're going to be working on teacher of the week. For student, since we're coming up on AP season, we're going to be working on mental awareness and stress relief. For athletics I know they're still working with loud crowd on collecting videos and making compilations."
