Inter Club Council (ICC) Bylaws:

- In order to be considered an official Dana Hills Club, all clubs must fill out a club application located on the Dana Hills High School Schoolloop Webpage.
 - a. A complete application consists of a:
 - Dana Hills High School Request for Organization of a New Club
 - ii. Club Constitution
 - iii. Club Faculty Advisor Agreement
 - iv. President Contact Form
- 2. Clubs are approved/denied at ASU cabinet meetings held every Monday of the Week
- 3. A teacher cannot be the advisor for more than two clubs.
- 4. There will be a mandatory ICC meeting every month unless otherwise notified by the ICC president.
- 5. Clubs must have at least one meeting every 6 weeks and turn in the corresponding meeting's minutes by the end of the month (via email or ICC Box)
- 6. Clubs will be under a three strike policy
 - a. Strikes will be given for:
 - i. Missing ICC Meetings
 - ii. Failure to Complete Service Project
 - iii. Failure to Submit Meeting Minutes within a month after the meeting took place
 - b. Clubs will be disbanded if they receive three strikes or more and will serve a one year moratorium that begins the next academic year.

- c. Officers of disbanded clubs cannot create a new club during their one year moratorium.
- 7. ICC President and ICC Deputy for the upcoming year will be elected at the last ICC Meeting of every year
