Other Leadership Training

Evidence of regular leadership training activities for student council members:

On Google Classroom, Ken Nedler, Sandra Mesa, and Carrie Pierce, will provide various leadership training assignments for student council members in the Student Leadership class. For example, one of our assignments in a Weekly Self Evaluation (attached). You fill out your leadership values for the week and how you carried out and demonstrated initiative, kindness, serving others, and connecting with others. Our goal is to report our week and encourage ourselves to go out of our comfort zone to reach out to other new people a part of our student body.
