

Dana Hills High School PTSA TERI LYNN O'BRIEN SENIOR SCHOLARSHIP

The Teri Lynn O'Brien Memorial Scholarship was established in the Spring of 2010 to commemorate the life of Teri O'Brien who served as the DHHS PTSA President from 2005-2007 in recognition of her dedication to the students of Dana Hills High School and her strong commitment to education. This \$1,000 scholarship is awarded to graduating seniors with financial need who have demonstrated strong citizenship and character as well as a commitment to advancing his or her education.

This scholarship is to be used for continuing education at a four-year college or university, a community college or a trade/technical school. The amount of each scholarship and the number of scholarships awarded will vary each year.

ELIGIBILITY

- You must be a 2023 graduating senior at Dana Hills High School.
- Financial Need
- You must have a minimum overall GPA of 2.0 (unweighted).

TO APPLY

- Complete application, include essay, record of volunteer service activities and reference.
- The application and all attachments should be emailed to scholarships.dhhsptsa@gmail.com on or before March 15, 2023.

PAYMENT OF AWARD

Recipients will be notified at the Senior Awards Ceremony. The decision of the PTSA Scholarship committee is final. **Note:** A scholarship award may be revoked in the event the student does not maintain the required overall GPA of 2.0, if the student is subject to severe disciplinary action such as suspension or expulsion, or if the student fails to enroll in an institution of higher education.
